Guidelines about usage of social media at Khwaja Yunus Ali Medical College and Hospital

Medical students and staff must uphold the strictest standards of patient confidentiality and institutional privacy on social media. Never share clinical photos, specific case details, or location check-ins without clear written consent from college/ hospital authority. Always separate your personal and professional identities to avoid severe academic, legal, or professional consequences.

The following rules should be abided by the KYAMC Students and Staff members:

1. Zero-Tolerance Rules for Privacy

- **Never Identify Patients:** Even de-identified information or "funny" stories about cases can be pieced together by the public to identify a patient.
- **No College Interior/ Ward Photography:** Do not take photos or videos of lecture halls, office, patients, patient records, or medical charts in the hospital or clinical setting.
- **Post-Mortem Confidentiality:** Patient privacy obligations extend beyond a patient's death.
- **Avoid Medical Advice:** Do not diagnose or offer specific medical advice through public social networks.


2. Maintain Professional Boundaries

- **Do Not "Friend" Patients:** Avoid accepting or requesting patients as friends or connections on personal accounts.
- **Refrain from Derogatory Comments:** Making negative, informal, or inappropriate remarks about patients, colleagues, or the hospital environment is a breach of professional conduct.
- **Do Not Speak for the Institution:** Do not represent yourself as an official spokesperson for the hospital or medical college without authorization.

3. Protect Your Own Professional Image

- **Assume Content is Permanent:** Deleted posts or "private" messages can easily be screenshotted and shared publicly, potentially seen by future employers and residency directors.
- **Audit Your Accounts:** Regularly review your privacy settings, photos, and tagged posts across all platforms to ensure they reflect a professional image.
- **Follow Ethical Guidelines:** Familiarize yourself with the Code of Medical Ethics: Guidelines of Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BMDC) regarding social media.

Violating the guidelines would be resulted in strict disciplinary actions, ranging from formal warnings and suspensions to permanent termination or other legal actions. Your cooperation and understanding regarding usage of social media guidelines would be appreciated.
